Q1. What are moral rights ?

Ans 1: The moral rights are based on the moral values of the society. The types of moral values available in society, assure moral rights of the people. For example, the rights of parents, the rights of husband and wife etc. The law does not come into operation by itself, if these rights are not fulfilled.

Q2. Write Holland's definition of rights.

Ans 1: "Right is that faculty of a person, which is affected by the force, or opinion of a society instead of his personal acts, or power."

Q3. Define economic rights ?

Ans 1: The aim of economic right is to enable an individual to enjoy economic security. These rights have acquired great prominence.

Q4. Write Austin's definition of rights.

Ans 1: "Right is that claim or power of a person with which he advises patience and performance of duties to others."

Q5. What is duty ?

Ans 1: Duty is that responsibility which a person imposes upon himself for the welfare and pleasure of other, and avoids to do the harmful ones.

Q6. Define political rights ?

Ans 1: Political rights are necessary for the political development of the citizens and for the rule of democracy.

Q7. Define the civil rights ?

Ans 1: Civil rights are concerned with the civic life of a man. Civil rights are those rights without which an individual cannot perform his duties in society. These rights are available to all the citizens of a state without any distinction.

Q8. What are rights ?

Ans 1: Rights are those demands for the welfare of the people which are fulfilled and recognized by the government.

Q9. Write Prof. Lasky's definition of rights.

Ans 1: "Rights are those requisites of social life without which no man can accomplish his personality."
