Q1. What do you know about the Lahore Resolution 1940 ?

Ans 1: The historical annual session of the All India Muslim League was held in Iqbal Park (Minto Park) Lahore on 23rd March 1940. The meeting was presided over by the Quaid-e-Azam and a large number of Muslims. Maulvi Fazal-e-Haq, a renowned Bengali leader, presented the resolution. They passed the resolution with great zeal. The Muslims set the clear goal on that historic day.

Q2. What do you know about the Muslim League ?

Ans 1: All India Muslim League was established in 1906 at Dhaka where the annual session of the Muhammadan Educational Conference was held. The Muslim League looked after the political interests of the Muslims.

Q3. Write two points from the fourteen points of Quaid-e-Azam ?

Ans 1: 1. The form of the future constitution should be federal with the residuary powers vested in the provinces.
2. A uniform measure of autonomy shall be granted to all provinces.

Q4. What is an ideology ?

Ans 1: Ideology is a different form of those comprehensive patterns of moral beliefs about man, society and the universe in relation to man and society.

Q5. What is national integration ?

Ans 1: National integration means to integrate all the social and political groups of a society to form a nation. The national integration and prosperity of any country is not possible without unity and cohesion.

Q6. Write two points of the 3rd June Plan 1947 ?

Ans 1: i. A commission for each of the two provinces was to be set up by the Governor General to demarcate the boundaries of the two parts of Punjab and Bengal.
ii. A referendum was also to be held in the district of Sylhet to the partition of Bengal. The people of Sylhet would like to be amalgamated with the Muslim part of Bengal.

Q7. Write two objectives of the Muslim League ?

Ans 1: 1. To create an understanding between the government and the Indian Muslims, and to promote the feelings of loyalty among them.
2. To coordinate with other nations and political parties for the general welfare of the people.
