Q5. Which are the major areas of Rice growing crop.

Ans 1: i - Punjab Province: In Pakistan, larger portion of rice is grown in Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Kashur, Lahore and Okara districts of Punjab Province.

Ans 2: ii- Sindh Province: In Sindh province, rice is grown in Sukkur, Larkana, Gaddu and Kotri Barrage areas.

Ans 3: iii- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province: Rice is grown in Dera Ismail Khan, Peshawar and Kurram Agency in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Q6. Which are the major areas of Cotton growing crop.

Ans 1: i- Area of Central and South Punjab: The crop is sown in irrigated areas of Punjab and Sindh. In central Punjab, Cotton is popular crop.

Ans 2: ii- Sindh Province: the district of Hyderabad, Badin, Sukkar, Thatha, Nawab shah, Nowshero feroze, Ghotki and thar Parker play an important role in cotton production.

Ans 3: iii-Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province: In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, cotton crop cultivation is very limited, Bannu and Dera Ismail Khan Area play an important role in Cotton production.

Ans 4: iv- Baluchistan Province: In Baluchistan, cotton crop cultivation is very limited. While in Baluchistan, cotton is cultivated in the areas of Jaffarabad, Nasirabad and some areas of Kalat Division.

Q7. Write note on Jinnah Barrage.

Ans 1: This is the first barrage of Punjab province located on the Indus river, Mianwali, Bhakkar and Layyah districts are being irrigated by the Thal canal flows out from the Jinnah Barrage.

Ans 4: iv- Enhancement of Facilities: Repair of old roads and construction of new roads as well as enhancement of railway facilities.

Ans 5: v- Provide irrigation facilities: To provide irrigation facilities to 1.6 million acres of cultivable land.
