Q1. What is Early childhood ?

Ans 1: Early childhood is the period in the child's life that extends from 2-6 years.

Q2. Define Adolescence.

Ans 1: Adolescence is the period of consummation. It starts when puberty ends. Normally girls attain adolescence at the age of 15 and boys at the age of 18.

Q3. What do you mean by the term Childhood ?

Ans 1: The phase of childhood extends from the end of early childhood to the advent of puberty. Expanded over 7-12 years, this phase is the onset of puberty.

Q4. What is Development ?

Ans 1: Woolfolk (1998) explains the process of development, "certain changes that occur in human beings (or animals) between conception and death. These appear in orderly ways and remain for a reasonably long period of time".

Q5. Define Infancy.

Ans 1: Infancy is the period that expands from birth of first two years of the child's life.
