Q1. What is meant by nisab of Zakaat ?

**Ans 1:** Nisab is someone's minimum fixed property or income on which Zakaat is due and which has been in his possession for the period of one complete year. Zakaat is payable not only on cash but also on jewelry, gold , silver, animals, agricultural land, crops and all kinds of commercial goods. The Nisab or fixed amount of property upon which Zakaat is due varies according to the kind of property in possession.

Q2. Who have the true fear of Allah ?

**Ans 1:** In he Holy Quran Allah says:  
Among His devotees, those truly fear Allah who have knowledge.

Q3. What was the condition for battle of Badr prisoners ?

**Ans 1:** In the battle of Badr, the Muslims caught come non-believers as the prisoners of war. The Holy Prophet (ﷺ) made it a condition that a prisoner must teach ten children of Muslims to read and write in order to get freedom.

**Ans 1:** The Holy Quran with its complete text was not revealed at one and the same time. Rather it was revealed little by little. It took about twenty-three years for this Divine Book to be completed. Whenever some Quranic verses were revealed, the Holy Prophet (ﷺ) sent for the scribe and dictated the revelation to him. The Holy Prophet (ﷺ) also gave him the instructions as to where the new verses to be included. i.e., in which Surah and before or after which verses they were to be included. The passage of the revelation was placed at a fixed place in Masjid-e-Nabvi.

Q8. What is the greatness of man ?
