Q1. What do you know about Pak-Afghan Relations ?

Ans 1: Afghanistan is a neighboring country of Pakistan. Durand line divides the borders of Pakistan and Afghanistan, which is about 2252 Km long. Both countries are connected through hilly passes. The relations between the two countries are friendly, and there is a hope of starting new era of relationships.

Q2. What do you know about the Lahore Resolution 1940 ?

Ans 1: The historical annual session of all India Muslims League was held in Iqbal Park (Minto Park) Lahore on 23rd March 1940. the meeting was presided over by the Quaid-e-Azam and a large number of Muslims. Maulvi Fazal-e-Haq a renowned Bengali leader presented the resolution. They passed the resolution with great zel. The Muslims set the clear goal on that historic day.

Q3. Write any two points on the importance of Objective Resolution ?

Ans 1: i. the objective Resolution is one of the greatest step after independence.
ii. The objective Resolution has attained the status of Magna Carta in the constitutional history of Pakistan.

Q4. What is an ideology ?

Ans 1: All India Muslim League was established on 1906 at Dhaka where the annual session of Muhammadan Educational Conference was held. Muslim League looked after the political interests of the Muslims.

Q9. Write an two points of 3rd June Plan 1947 ?

Ans 1: i. A commission for each of the two provinces was to be set up by the Governor General to demarcate the boundaries of the two parts of Punjab and Bengal.
ii. A referendum was also to be held in the district of Sylhet to the partition of Bengal. The people of Sylhet would like to be amalgamated with the Muslims part of Bengal.

Q10. Write any three provisions of the Objective Resolution ?

Ans 1: 1. Sovereignty belongs to Allah Almighty alone.
2. State will exercise its powers and authority through the elected representatives of the people.
3. Judiciary shall be independent and shall work without any pressure.

Q11. What do you know about Union Council ?

Ans 1: There are twenty one members in the Union Council, Twelve out of them are members in the union council. The members of the Union Council are directly elected by the people in a multi member constituency.

Q12. What are moral rights ?

Ans 1: The moral rights are based on the moral values of the society. The types of moral values available in society, assure moral rights of the people. For example, the rights of parents, the rights of husband and wife etc. The law does not come into operation by itself, if these rights are not fulfilled.
