Q1. How did John Dewey define 'education' ?

Ans 1: John Dewey said, "Education is the reconstruction and reorganization of experience, that adds to the meaning, of experience and directs the way to the subsequent experiences.

Q2. Define 'scope of education'.

Ans 1: The scope of education refers to the extent and nature of changes occurred in human personality due to the educative process.

Q3. Suggest two points which a student should act upon for being socially adjusted.

Q4. Define "Transmission of cultural heritage."
