Q1. Define learning through role playing

Q2. Write down four types of learning.

Q3. Define 'learning by imitation'.

Ans 1: Learning by imitation refers to the learning process which is characterized by the actual copying of the behavior of others. If a child follows the accent of his mother, this is what we say imitative learning.

Q4. Define attitude.

Ans 1: Attitude refers to favorable or unfavorable evaluations of reaction to objects, people situations or other aspects of the world.

Q5. Write three examples of learning by imitation from the educational settings.

1. Adaptation of pronunciation of the students with that of the teacher.

Q7. Define insight theory of learning.
