Q2. Write three important features of the 1973 Constitution.

2- The official religion of Islam, while the President and the Prime Minister were made mandatory to be Muslims.
3- Muslims were defined and Ahmadis were declared as non Muslims.

Q3. Write down the five Islamic Provisions under 1973 Constitution.

Q4. When and who conducted the general elections of 1970

Q6. Who assumed the office of Prime Minister after winning the 1990 elections.
