Q1. Write 3 fundamental rights enjoyed by citizens under the 1973 Constitution.

Ans 1: 1. Every citizen is allowed to assemble peacefully.
2- Every person has full freedom to buy property.
3. Every citizen has complete freedom of movement in Pakistan.

Q2. State the duties of Islamic Ideological Council.

Ans 1: The Council of Islamic Ideology guides the legislative bodies to make laws conform to Islamic teachings.

Q3. Briefly write on the responsibilities of the Chief Secretary.

Ans 1: The Chief Secretary is the head of the province for administration affairs, He is the secretary of the provincial cabinet and is responsible for implementing its decisions.

Q4. Who President Zia-ul-Haq announced the formation of Majlis Shura.

Ans 1: In December 1981, President Zia Ul Haq announced the formation of a nominated Majlis Shura which lasted until February 1985.

Q5. General Elections 1970 were held on which basis.

Ans 1: General Elections were held in the country in December 1970 on the basis of adult voting.

Q6. Explain the definition of Muslim according to the 1973 Constitution.

Ans 1: A person who believes in Tawheed, Prophethood, Resurrection and the Divine Books, besides believing a prophet Muhammad Rasool Allah Khatam-un-Nabiyeen as the last Prophet, is a Muslim.

Q7. Write short about One Unit.

Ans 1: The western part of the country consisted of four provinces, the states acceding to Pakistan, while the eastern part consisted of one province. To overcome this obstacle, the four provinces of West Pakistan were merged into one province named as One Unit.

Q8. When and who dismissed the government of Muhammad Khan Junejo.

Ans 1: On May 29, 1988, President General Muhammad Zia-ul-Haq dismissed the government of Muhammad Khan Junejo.

Q9. When East Pakistan was separated.

Ans 1: On December 16, 1971, East Pakistan was separated from Pakistan and formed a new country called Bangladesh.

Q10. No-confidence motion was successful against which Prime Minister of Pakistan.

Ans 1: In April 2008, after the success of the no-confidence motion against Imran Khan, Mian Muhammad Shahbaz Sharif was elected as the new Prime Minister of the country.
