Q1. Write in brief about National Security Council.

Ans 1: The National Security Council is chaired by the Prime Minister which looks after all the security matters of the country and formulates national security policies which are required to be implemented by the federal and provincial government.

Q2. Where is the Supreme Appellate Court established.

Ans 1: The Supreme Appellate Court is established in Gilgit-Baltistan.

Q3. Write three functions of Union Council.

Ans 1: 1- To approve the budget of the council and to approve taxes or fees.
2- Rehabilitating public roads, streets, cemeteries, gardens and sports fields.
3- To appoint the members of the Panchayat and monitor their performance.

Q4. According to which article, the federal government can acquire land in all provinces.

Ans 1: According to Article 152 of the Constitution the federal government can acquire land in all provinces for projects undertaken for national purposes.

Q5. Under which Article, the Provincial Governments exercise administrative powers? Analyze.

Ans 1: According to Article 149 of the constitution the provincial governments exercise administrative powers.
