

Q9. What is histogram.

- **Ans 1:** A histogram consists of a set of adjacent rectangles having bases along the X- axis, with centres at class marks and areas proportional to the class frequencies.
- **Ans 2:** If the class interval sizes are equal, the height of the rectangles are also proportional to the class frequencies and are taken numerically equal to the class frequencies.
