Ans 1: Pakistan ranks fifth in the world in sugarcane production. sugarcane is a major cash crop in Pakistan after cotton. River plains are very fertile and with the help of canal irrigation sugar is cultivated at large area of Pakistan. Punjab dominate in sugarcane production and more than 65.4 percent production of total sugar cane comes from Punjab province. While Sindh produces 26.5% and KPK 8.1% sugar of total sugarcane production. Pakistan is self sufficient in sugar and some time export to other countries of the world.

Q7. Which countries of the continent of Europe cultivate sugar cane ?

Ans 1: Sugar cane does best in the tropical and sub-tropical countries of the world, therefore the climate of Europe is not suitable for sugar cane crop, it is not significant in sugar cane production only Spain and Portugal produce some quantity of sugar cane.
