Q1. Write down area of Pakistan according to Govt of Pakistan statistics?

Ans 1: Pakistan covers an area of about 3,10,403 sq miles 7,96096 sq Km, making it nearly four times as large as Great Britain, or one fourth of the size of India. About (84000 sq Km/33000 sq miles) of "Gilgit-Baltistan" and Azad Kashmir administered by Pakistan since 1949, is not included in total area of Pakistan.

Q2. Write down about success achieved by Muslims of Sub-continent in 1908?

Ans 1: The year 1908 is milestone in the history of sub-continent. In this year separate electrole was accepted for Muslims on the Minto-Marlay agreement.

Q3. Write down location of Pakistan?

Ans 1: Pakistan is located between 60°.50 to 77°.5 east longitude and 23°.35 to 37°.05 north latitude.

Q4. At the time of Independence, what was population of West Pakistan?

Ans 1: At the time of Independence population of Pakistan was 3 crore and 25 lakh people.

Q5. In which year "Pakistan Resolution" was passed?

Ans 1: "Pakistan Resolution" was passed on 23rd March 1940.

Q6. Pakistan's southern border is common with whom and write down its length?

Ans 1: The Arabian Sea lies in the south of our country. The southern coast is 600 miles (1000 km) long. Which is shared by the provinces of Sindh (300 km long) and Baluchistan (700 km).

Q7. When was division of sub-continent decided?

Ans 1: It was decided on 3rd June 1947 to divide sub-continent (India) into two countries.

Q8. At the time of independence, how many Muslims were in the sub-continent?

Ans 1: At the time of independence, there were 100 million Muslims in the sub-continent.
