Q1. When George Stefinson invented Steam railway engine ?

Ans 1: Railway engine was invented in 1825 in England by George Stefinson.

Q2. Write down total length of electrified railway track in Pakistan ?

Ans 1: In Pakistan, total length of electrified railway track is 289 Km. But now it is not operational.

Q3. In 1991, how many kilometers railway track in Pakistan was closed down ?

Ans 1: In 1991, 374 Kilometers railway track was closed down in Pakistan.

Q4. Write down total railway track laid down in the sub-continent at the time of Independence in India - Pakistan ?

Ans 1: At the time of Independence total length of railway track laid down in subcontinent was 66,206 Kilometers.

Q5. When and between which cities of Pakistan first railway line was constructed ?

Ans 1: The first track of railway was laid between Karachi and Kotri covering a distance of 169 Km in 1861.

Q6. Write down length of Quetta - Zahidan railway track and name important railway stations on this track ?

Ans 1: The length of railway track between Quetta and Zahidan is 610 kilometers. This length is from Quetta to border city MirJava. Nushki, Dalbandin, Nok - Kundi, Taftan, and MirJava are important railway stations at this track.

Q7. Until June 2016, write down length of railway track, number of railway stations and number of railway engines in Pakistan ?

Ans 1: Until June 2016, Pakistan possesses 7791 Km railway track, 808 railway stations and 455 railway engines.

Q8. In Pakistan, between which cities electrified railway system have been established ?

Ans 1: In Pakistan, between Lahore and Khanewal electrified railway track have been established. Now it is not operational.

Q9. Write down length of railway track between Quetta and Rohri ?

Ans 1: The length of railway track between Quetta & Rohri is 835 kilometers. The Rohri-Quetta track runs via Habibkot, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Sibi, Bolan pass, Spezand and Quetta, This railway continues from Quetta to Chaman and Quetta to Zhob.

Q10. Write down length of railway track laid down between Karachi & Peshawar via Lahore, and name important cities at this track ?

Ans 1: The length of railway track between Karachi and Peshawar via Lahore is 1681 Km (1043 miles), important stations on this route are Nowshera, Taxila, Rawal Pindi, Jhelum, Lala Musa, Gujrat, Gujranwal, Lahore, Sahiwal, Multan, Bahawalpur, Rahimyar Khan, Rohri Khairpur, Nowabshah, Hyderabad and Karachi.
