Q1. According to which article, the federal government can acquire land in all provinces.

Ans 1: According to Article 152 of the Constitution the federal government can acquire land in all provinces for projects undertaken for national purposes.

Q2. State three functions of a District or Tehsil Council.

Ans 1: 1- To create the spirit of welfare works and social reform among the citizens.
2- To evaluate the performances of district or tehsil officers.
3- To construct bridges and other public buildings.

Q3. Introduce the Municipal Town Council.

Ans 1: The directly elected members from all constituencies in the municipality or town are ex-officio committee members, apart from them 5 women, 3 non-Muslims, 2 Labour workers and one youth are included.

Q4. Where were local governments established.

Ans 1: In August 2001, local governments were established under the presidential order.

Q5. State the different levels of local governments.

Ans 1: Under local governments, a two-tier system was created in rural areas and a three-tier system was created in urban areas.

Q6. What duties does the Chief Officer perform.

Ans 1: A Chief officer is a senior civil servant who oversees and coordinates all departments.

Q7. Where is the Supreme Appellate Court established.

Ans 1: The Supreme Appellate court is established in Gilgit-Baltistan.

Q8. State the status of the President of Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

Ans 1: The President is the constitutional head of Azad Jammu and Kashmir who is elected by the Kashmir Legislative Assembly for a term of five years.

Q9. Write in brief about National Security Council.

Ans 1: The National Security Council is chaired by the Prime Minister which looks after all the security matters of the country and formulates national security policies which are required to be implemented by the federal and provincial government.

Q10. What do you know about Gilgit-Baltistan? Write a short note.

Ans 1: In 2009, the Pakistan People's party gave limited autonomy to the northern region by naming Gilgit-Baltistan. The Legislative Assembly was established and its elections were held and the Gilgit-Baltistan Council was established.
