Q1. Write down three functions of the metropolitan corporations in brief.

Ans 1: 1- To approve land plans, environmental plans and urban plans.
2- To approve and enforce laws and bylaws.

Q2. State The status of the President of Azad Jammu and Kashmir

Ans 1: The President is the constitutional head of Azad Jammu and Kashmir who is elected by the Kashmir Legislative Assembly for a term of five years.

Q3. What duties does the Chief Officer perform.

Ans 1: A Chief officer is a senior civil servant who oversees and coordinates all departments.

Ans 1: In 2009, the Pakistan People's party gave limited autonomy to the northern region by naming Gilgit-Baltistan. The Legislative Assembly was established and its elections were held and the Gilgit-Baltistan Council was established.

Ans 1: 1- the jurisdiction of the federal government covers the entire country while the authority of the provincial government is limited to the respective province.
2- The prime Minister is accountable to the National Assembly while the Chief Minister is accountable to the respective Provincial Assembly.
