Q1. Write a note Gilgit Baltistan legislature members.

Ans 1: Gilgit Baltistan legislature consists of 33 members. Out of these 24 are directly elected by popular vote, 6 seats are reserved for women and three are reserved for technocrats.

Q2. Discuss Economic Reforms during Pervez Musharraf's Government.

Ans 1: During the rule of General Pervez Musharraf, the entire strategy as towards economic development when General Musharraf came to power, the global response to Pakistan's Nuclear test was having a negative impact on the economy. Pakistan's economic situation has improved despite the September 11, 2001 attacks on the world trade center in New York City, threats from India and the civil war in Afghanistan. Due to terrorist incidents in the United States, Pakistan became important. Due to the assistance of western countries, Pakistan's economy was supported and the economic growth was about seven percent. Overall this period can be called an economically stable period.
