Q1. In which script Pashto was written before the arrival of Muslims in the subcontinent.

Ans 1: It was written in Kharushi script

Q2. Write a note on Tashkent Agreement.

Ans 1: After the Indo-Pak war of 1965, the Russian President signed an agreement between India and Pakistan at Tashkent in January 1966 to resolve the issue of return of prisoners of war and occupation of territories.

Q3. Before the establishment of Pakistan, which personalities rendered valuable services for the development and promotion of Urdu.

Q4. Define Culture

Ans 1: Culture is the name of the common beliefs, way of life, customs, language and traditions of the people living in a place. Q5. Which are the major areas of cotton growing crop.

Ans 1: i- Area of Central and South Punjab: The crop is sown in irrigated areas of Punjab and Sindh. In central Punjab, cotton is a popular crop.

Ans 2: ii- Sindh Province: the districts of Hyderabad, Badin, Sukkar, Thatta, Nawabshah, Nowshera Feroze, Ghotki and Thar Parkar play an important role in cotton production.

Ans 4: iv- Baluchistan Province: In Baluchistan, cotton crop cultivation is very limited. While in Baluchistan, cotton is cultivated in the areas of Jaffarabad, Nasirabad and some areas of Kalat Division.
